Erratum

In the article 'The initial impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the diagnosis of new cancers at a large pathology laboratory in the public health sector, Western Cape Province, South Africa' by Van Wyk et al. (June 2021 SAMJ), there was a small error in the number of cases in the abstract under 'Results' and in the 4th paragraph of the 'Results' section: \dots decreased by 193 (-36.3%), from 532 \dots ' should have read '... decreased by 192 (–36.2%), from 531 ...' The incorrect figures appeared in the 'Online first' version of the article (published on 10 May 2021) and in the abstract in the June print version of SAMJ (p. 59), but the version in the June online SAMJ (pp. 570 - 574, https://doi.org/10.7196/ SAMJ.2021.v111i6.15580) is correct.
