Not far from Sossusvlei in the Namib Desert is Dead Vlei, which formed many centuries ago when the Tsauchab River flooded after heavy rains, creating shallow pools where trees came to grow. Over time the climate changed, severe drought struck, and sand dunes surrounded the pan, blocking it off from the river. Most of the trees died, although some hardy plant species, such as *salsola* and *lnara*, which can survive from mist and very occasional rainfall, survived. The dead trees are from 500 to 900 years old, blackened by the sun, but did not decompose because of the extreme dryness.
